IMPORTANT

1. CANDIDATES TO ENSURE THEIR ELIGIBILITY FOR THE POST.

1.1 The candidates applying for the post should ensure that they fulfill all eligibility conditions. Their admission at all the stages of the recruitment process will be purely provisional subject to satisfying the prescribed eligibility condition(s).

1.2 The K. V. NF RAILWAY RANGAPARA takes up verification of eligibility conditions with reference to original documents only after the candidates have qualified for interview.

2. APPLICATION FORM:

2.1 Candidates must apply in the Common Application Form devised by the K. V. NF RAILWAY RANGAPARA for this recruitment process and available with the advertisement inviting applications or may be downloaded from the Vidyalaya web site with U.R.L. <https://rangapara.kvs.ac.in/>

3. EXAMINATION FEES / APPLICATION FEE: NIL.

4. DOCUMENTS TO BE ATTACHED WITH THE APPLICATION

- 4.1 Two copies of recent photograph (size 35 x 45 mm) facing camera, out of which one duly self attested and one without attestation should be affixed with the application form.
- 4.2 Attested photocopies of all the educational qualifications, academic and professional, mark- sheets for all the years, degree/ diploma certificates starting from Senior Secondary/ Intermediate to highest academic/ professional qualification the candidate possesses, all certificates in claim of CCA, achievements/ distinction in Sports, Literary activities, Scouts & Guides, NCC, NSS etc., class X certificate for proof of date of birth, experience certificates etc. duly tagged with application together (**All Certificates shall be self attested**).

5. CORRESPONDENCE WITH THE K. V. NF RAILWAY RANGAPARA

5.1 The K. V. NF RAILWAY RANGAPARA will not enter into any correspondence with the candidates about their candidature.

5.2 The candidates should note that their admission to the recruitment process will be purely provisional based on the information given by them in the application form. This will be subject to verification of all the eligibility conditions by the K. V. NF RAILWAY RANGAPARA.

5.3 Candidates may note that the K. V. NF RAILWAY RANGAPARA takes up the verification of eligibility conditions of a candidate, with reference to original documents, only after the candidate has qualified for interview. Unless the candidature is formally confirmed by the K. V. NF RAILWAY RANGAPARA, it continues to be provisional.

5.4 The decision of the K. V. NF RAILWAY RANGAPARA as to the eligibility or otherwise of a candidate for admission to the recruitment process shall be final.

A. TRAINED GRADUATE TEACHERS

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS:

- i) Four Years Integrated Degree Course of Regional College of Education of NCERT in the concerned subject with at least 50% marks in aggregate; or Bachelor's Degree with at least 50% marks in the concerned subject/ combination of subject and in aggregate. The elective subjects and languages in the combination of subjects as under:

1.	TGT (English)	English as a subject in all the three years.
2.	TGT (Hindi)	Hindi as a subject in all the three years.
3.	TGT (S. St.)	Any two of the following:- History, Geography, Economics and Pol. Science of which one must be either History or Geography
4.	TGT (Science)	Botany, Zoology and Chemistry.
5.	TGT (Maths)	Bachelor Degree in Maths with any two of the following subjects: - Physics/ Chemistry/ Electronics/ Computer Science/ Statistics

- ii) B.Ed. or equivalent degree from a recognized University.
iii) Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET) conducted by the CBSE

- iv) Proficiency in teaching in Hindi and English medium.

Desirable: Knowledge of Computer Applications.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES FOR THE POST OF TRAINED GRADUATE TEACHERS (TGTs)

- A. The candidate should possess the professional qualification of B.Ed as on the last date of submission of application.
- B. **For the post of TGT (S.St.):**
1. The candidate should have studied any two subjects out of the following:
 - (i) History with atleast 50% marks in aggregate and one subject out of Geography/Economics/Political Science with atleast 50% marks in aggregate and also atleast 50% marks in graduation, **OR**
 - (ii) Geography with 50% marks with History/Economics/Political Science with atleast 50% marks in aggregate and also atleast 50% marks in graduation,
 2. Geography/History should have been studied in all the years of graduation with atleast 50% marks.
 3. In case of Honours Degree in History, the candidate should have studied Geography/Economics/Political Science in first and/or second year of graduation with atleast 50% marks in History in aggregate and atleast 50% marks in other subject indicated above at graduation level and also atleast 50% marks in aggregate at graduation level.
 4. Similarly in case of Honours degree in Geography, the candidate should have studied History/Economics/Political Science in first and/or second year of graduation with atleast 50% marks in Geography in aggregate and atleast 50% marks in other subject indicated above at graduation level and also atleast 50% marks in aggregate at graduation level.
- C. **For the post of TGT (Maths):**
1. The candidate should have studied Maths in all the years of graduation with any two subjects out of Physics, Chemistry, Electronics, Computer Science, Statistics.
 2. In case of Honours Degree in Maths, the candidate should have studied Maths in all the years of graduation with atleast 50% marks in aggregate and any of the two subjects indicated in point No.1 above with atleast 50% marks in each subject at graduation level and also atleast 50% marks in graduation..
 3. BA (Hons.) in Maths and B.Sc (Hons) in any subject other than Maths are not eligible for the post of TGT (Maths).
- D. **For the post of TGT (Science):**
1. The candidate should have studied Botany, Zoology and Chemistry in all the years of graduation with atleast 50% marks in each subject.
 2. The candidates with Honours Degree in Botany/Zoology/Chemistry with atleast 50% marks in B.Sc should have studied other two subjects with atleast 50% marks in each of them at graduation level.
- E. **For the posts of TGT (English/Hindi/Sanskrit):**
1. The candidate should have studied English/Hindi/Sanskrit in all the years of graduation with atleast 50% marks in English/Hindi/Sanskrit for the posts of TGT (English/Hindi/Sanskrit) respectively and also atleast 50% marks in graduation,

(iii) The candidate should possess two years Diploma in Education (D.Ed.) or Bachelor in Elementary Education (B.El.Ed.) and ii) iv) Competence to teach through Hindi and English medium.

E. COMPUTER INSTRUCTOR (PRIMARY & SECONDARY)

Essential:

- (i) BE/ B. Tech (Computer science)/ BCA/ MCA/ M.Sc. (Computer Science) Or
(ii) M.Sc. (Electronics with Computer Science component)/ M.Sc. (IT)/B.Sc. (Computer Science) Or

Bachelor's/ Master degree in any Science subject/ Mathematics from recognized university with Postgraduate Diploma in Computer application from government recognized University/ Institute. Or

Post-graduate degree in any subject with Postgraduate Diploma in Computer application from government recognized University/ 'O' level from DOEACC. Or

Post-graduate degree in any subject with minimum 'A' level from DOEACC.
(iii) Competence to teach through Hindi and English medium.

F. GAMES & SPORTS COACHES

Essential:

1. Bachelor's Degree in Physical Education or equivalent.
2. Competence to teach through English and Hindi medium.

Desirable: Knowledge of Computer Applications.

G. YOGA COACH

Essential:

Graduation in any subject or equivalent from a recognized university with one year training in Yoga from a recognized institution.

Desirable: Knowledge of Computer Applications.

SPECIAL PROVISION

i) **Relaxation of B.Ed. qualification** - In the absence of suitable candidates with B.Ed. Degrees in Hard/ Very Hard station and in remote areas of North-East and J&K, candidates with following qualification may be considered in different categories without B.Ed. qualification –

a) Post graduate with 60% marks in Science subjects and 55% in Humanities subjects may be considered for the posts of PGTs, if suitable candidates with B.Ed. are not available.

b) Similarly in the case of TGT, B.Sc. with 60% marks and BA with 55% marks may be considered for appointment on part-time contractual basis if suitable candidates with B.Ed. are not available.

- c) Graduates may be considered for the post of Primary Teacher if candidates with Senior Secondary/ Plus 2/ Inter with J.B.T. qualification are not available.
- ii) **Relaxation in CTET** – In the absence of CTET qualified candidate, candidate without CTET qualification may be considered if otherwise eligible as per KVS recruitment rules.

PART - VI: SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES

1. Qualifications acquired by the candidates should be strictly in accordance with the prescribed qualifications and candidate should not seek claim of equivalence of their qualifications with that of qualifications as asked for. Wherein grades have been given, equivalence marks of gradation should be attached.
2. The Candidate should not fill in those qualifications in the application form for which they have appeared in any of the examination whose result is awaited/ withheld/ not declared.
